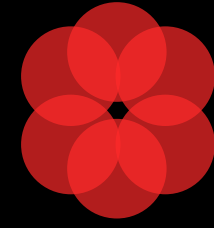

Bringing design, development, operations, strategy, research, and all product team roles under one roof with zero process tech debt.

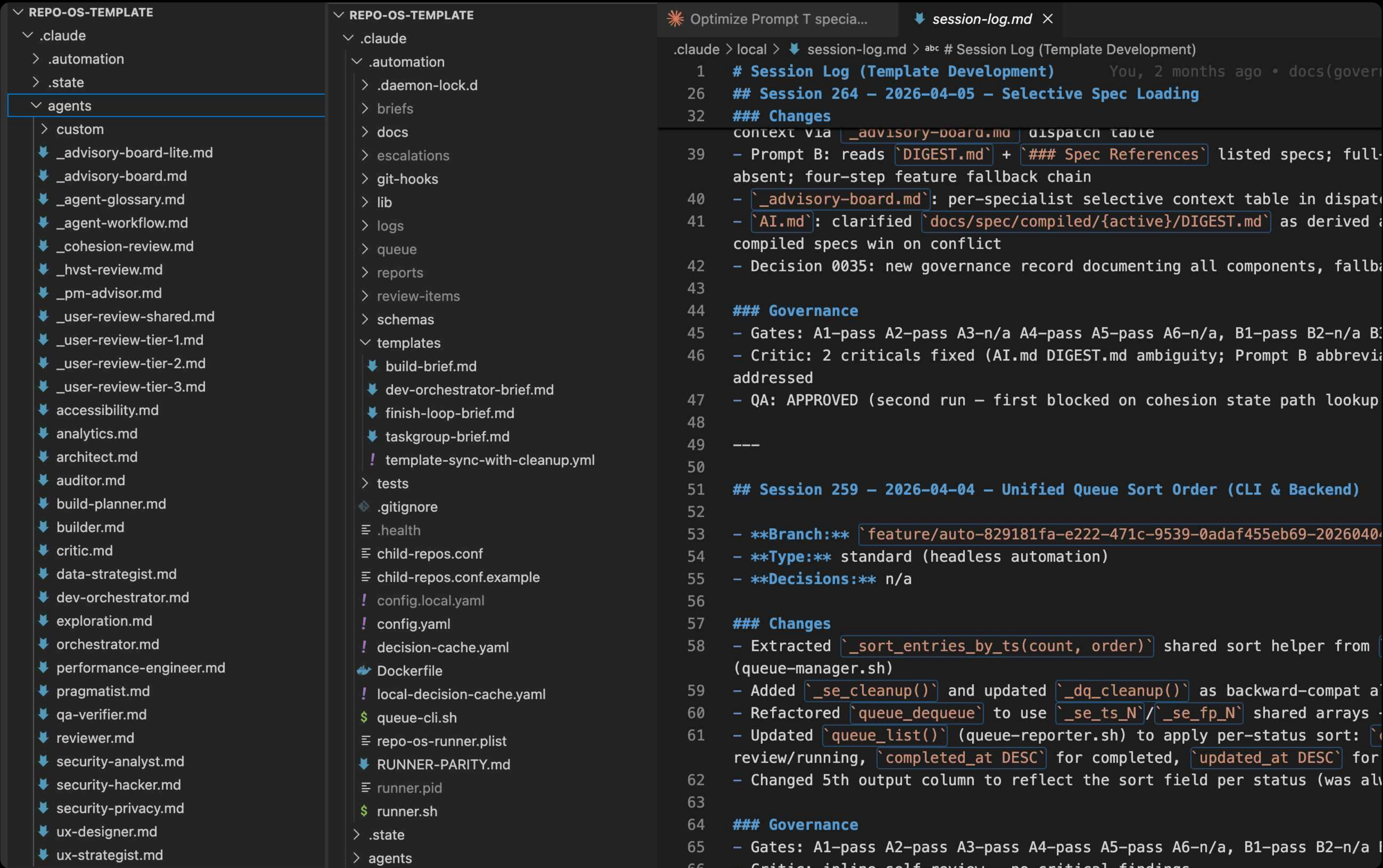
What is the goal of this exercise?

Built On The Repo OS Multi-Agent Model

A lightweight governance framework I built to ensure quality and protocol with AI coding agents, using structure, systems, and multi-agent workflow patterns.

Includes a built-in spec builder, quality gates, phased workflows with mechanical enforcement, and an integrated knowledge graph for both human and agent consumption.

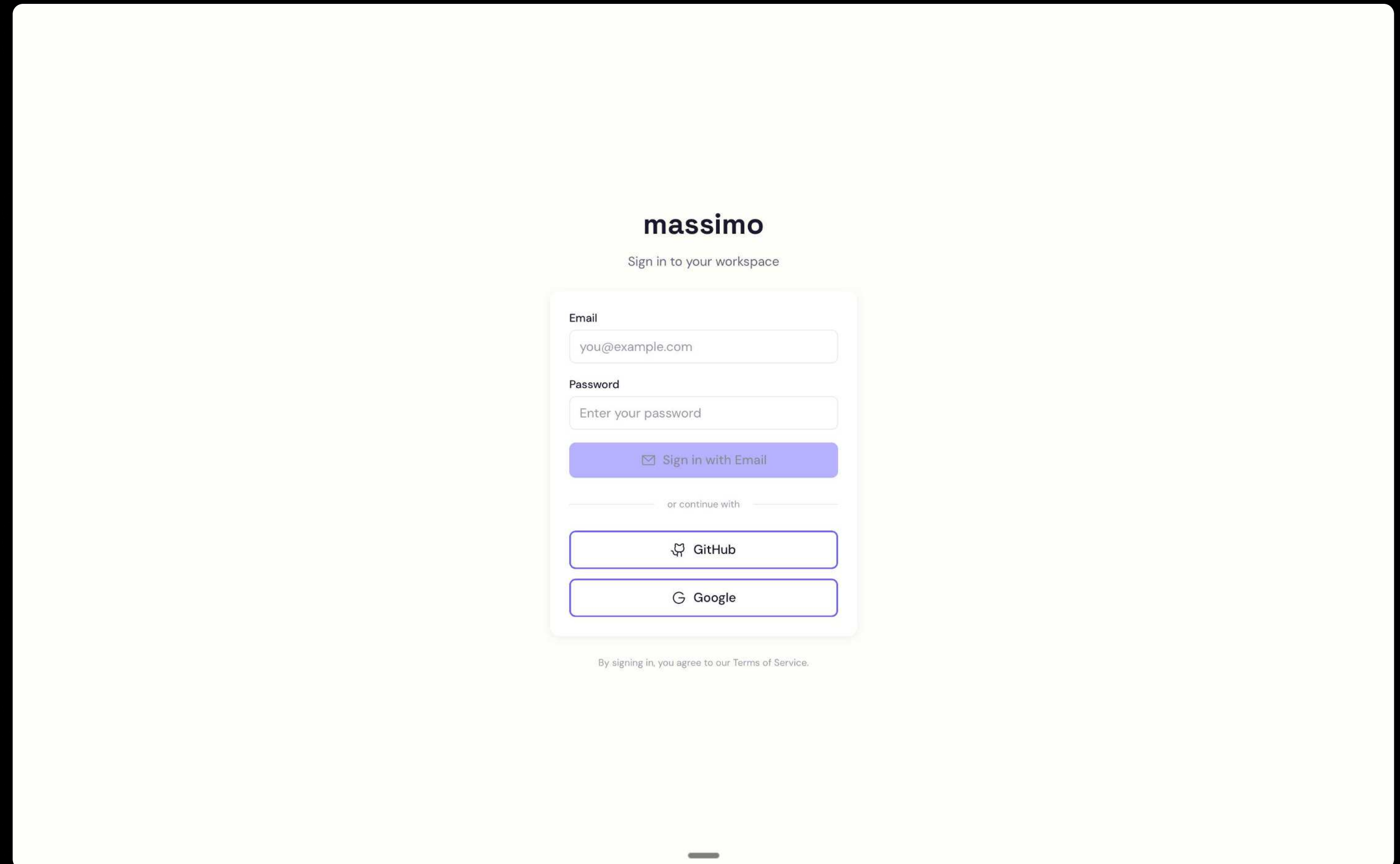


Going wide on version 1

Using a build-first approach to capture the full feature list, pressure test the initial product vision, and design the MVP by experiencing the users point-of-view.

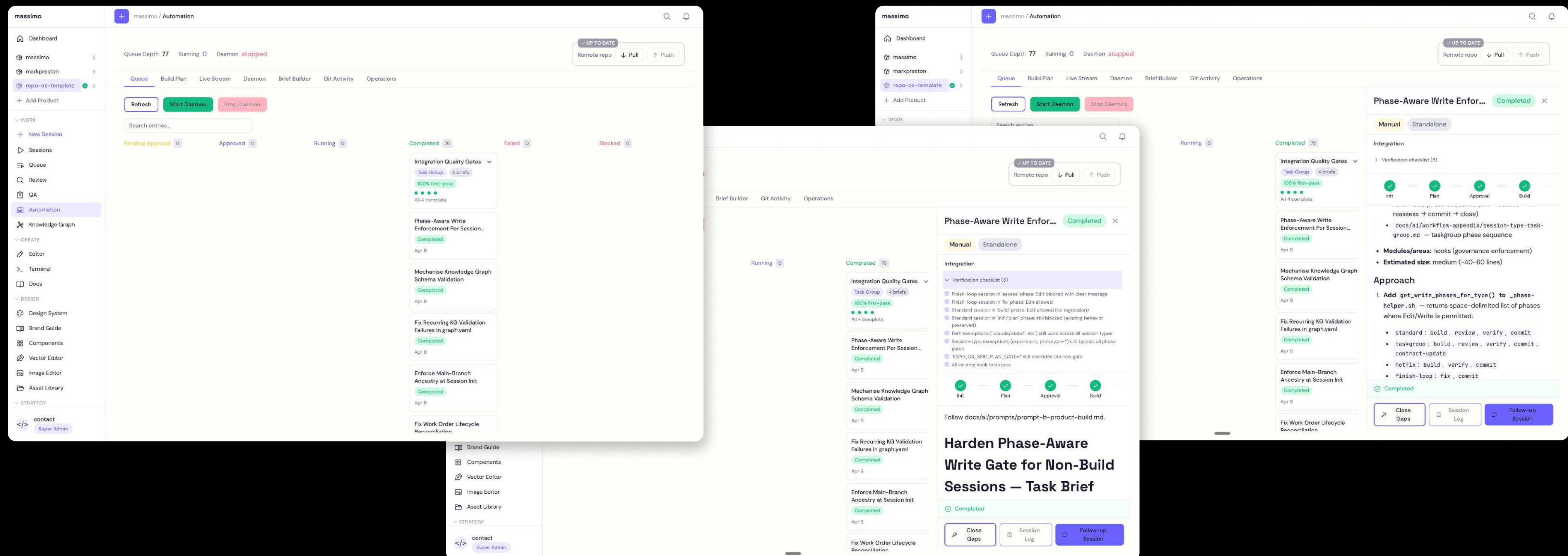
This also helped gauge the effort and complexity of each feature while designing the architecture and functionality for v2, the MVP shippable product.

What follows, is a showcase of highlighted features built and used in version 1.



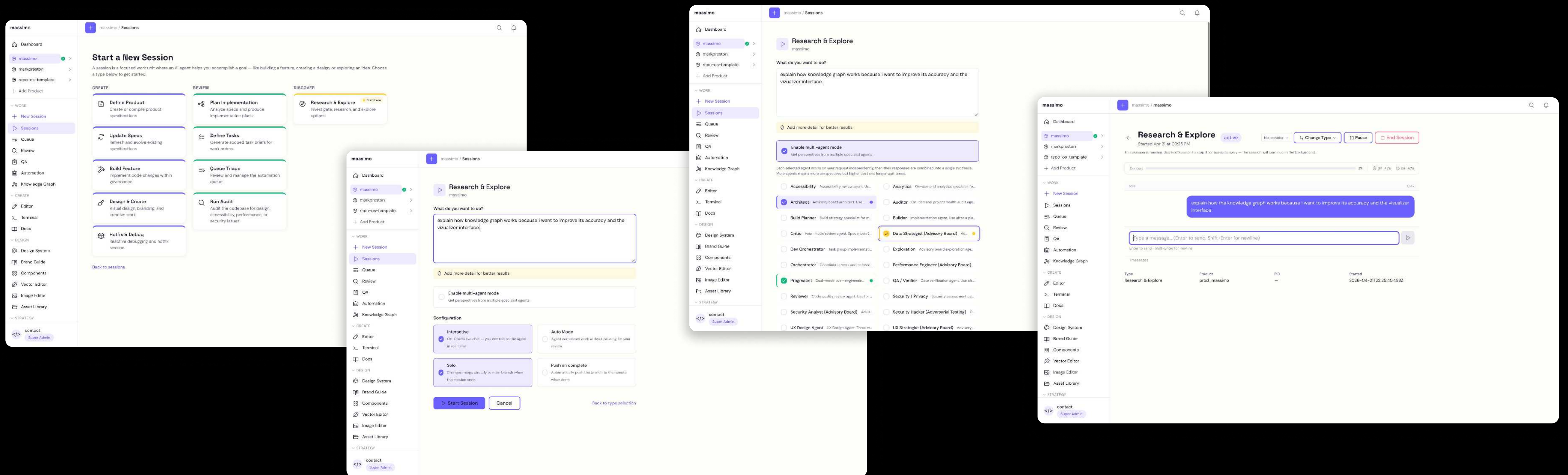
Automated Workflows For Autonomous Agents

Submit briefs to the automation queue through interactive sessions and manage autonomous work with built in review and follow options.



Structured Interactive Sessions

Pulling from the Repo OS prompt suite – sessions are optimized, structured, and designed for token-efficiency using short focused sessions. Governed by Repo OS workflows.



Integrated knowledge graph

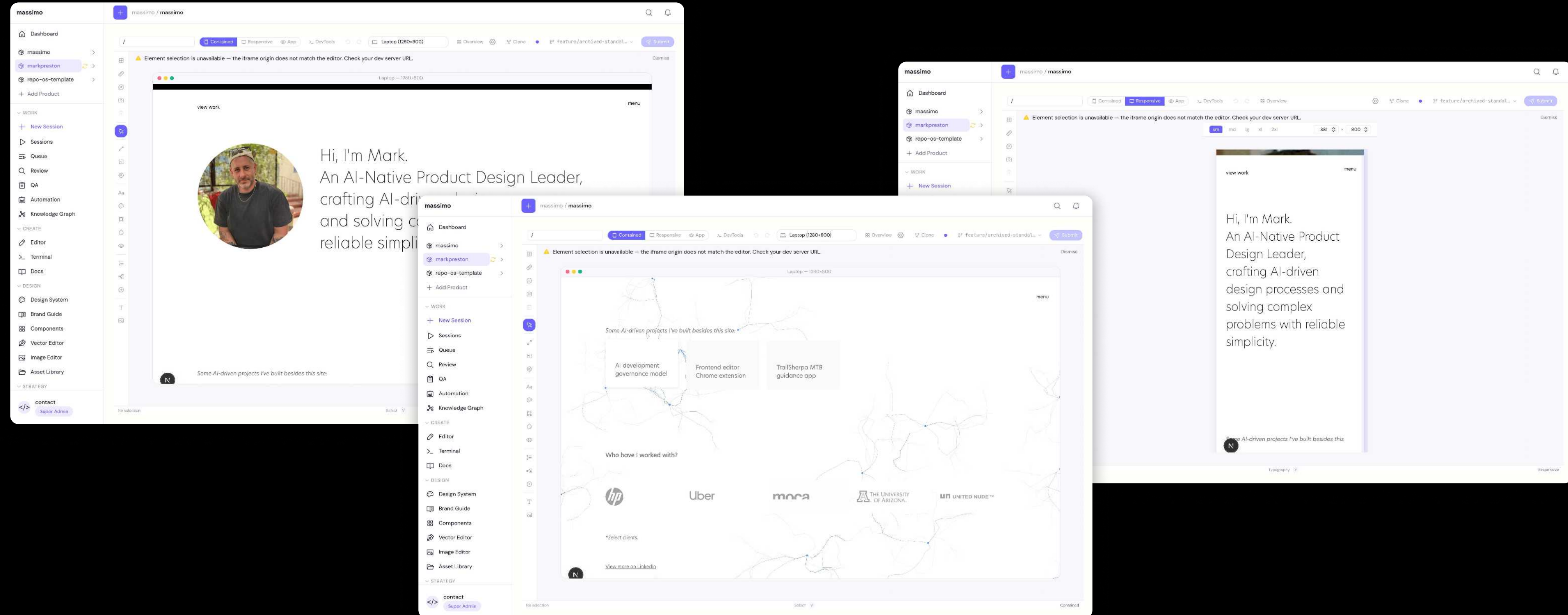
Woven into interactive and autonomous workflow sessions through Repo OS to efficiently identify dependencies and connections while planning and building features and products, includes a gap-identifier tool and health dashboard.



Full frontend editing tool for design

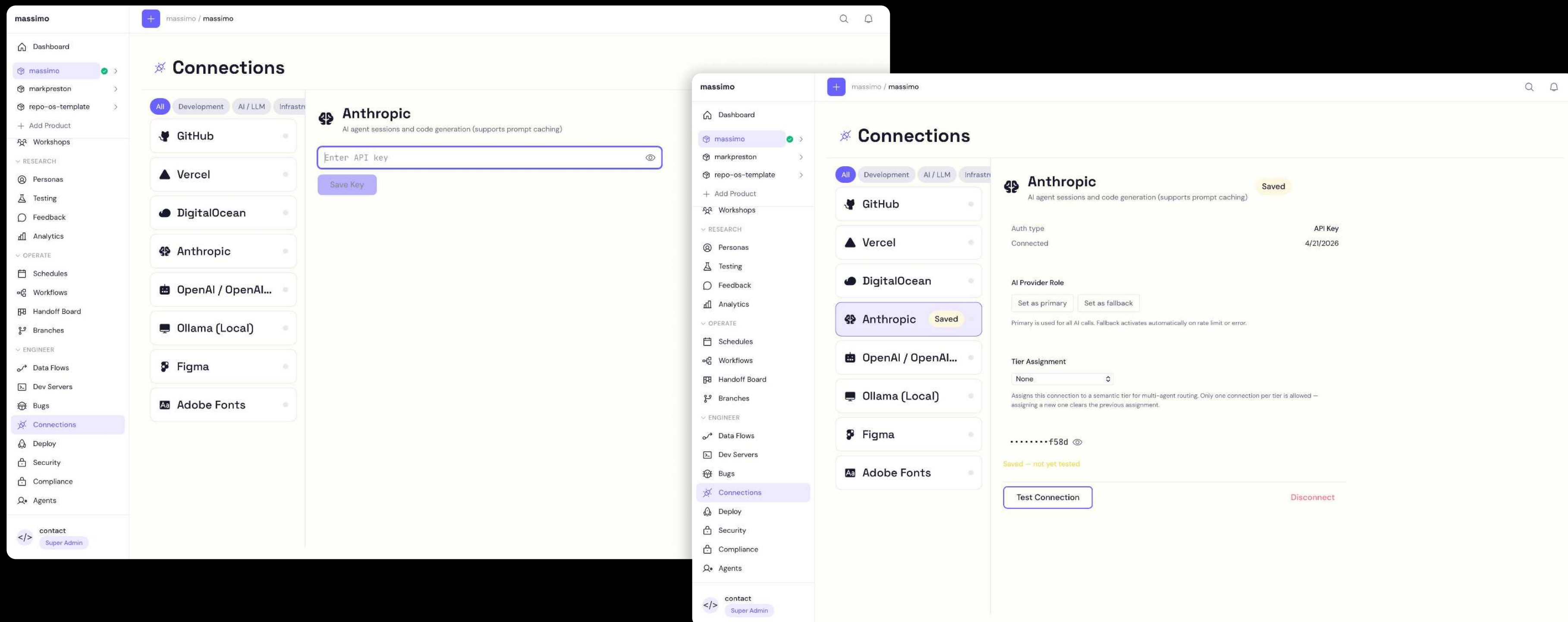
Integrating everything I built from the Frontend Editor Chrome Extension, allowing designers to work from source in isolated and governed AI sessions.

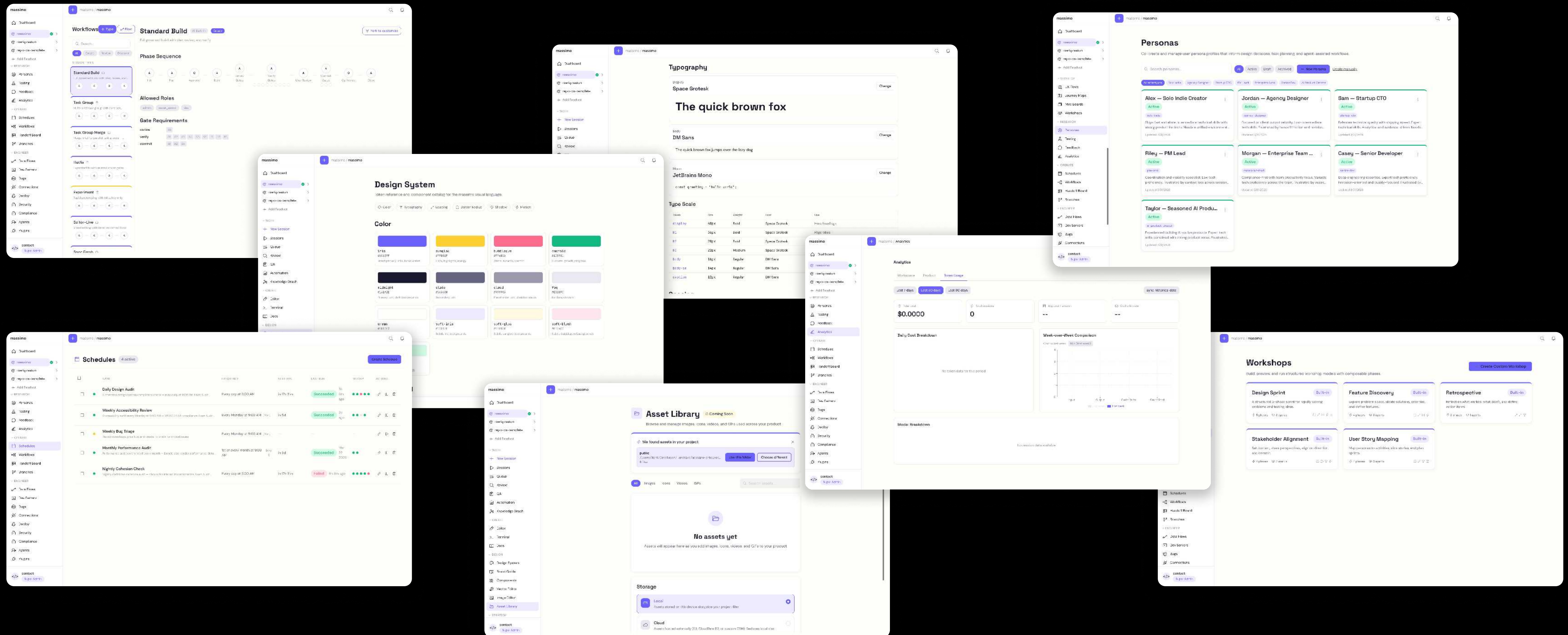
Connectors so Massimo fits into your workflow
